Keep OUT of Recycling Cart

Light Strands

Light strands can be recycled at the Olmsted County Recycling Center Plus.

Garland & Tinsel

Throw in household garbage.

Plastic Bags

Reuse, throw in household garbage, or bring to a bag-return bin at a grocery store or big-box retailer.

Batteries

Lithium and rechargeable batteries should be brought to the Olmsted County Hazardous Waste Facility.

Single-use alkaline batteries can go in the trash.

Electronics

Bring to the Olmsted County Recycling Center Plus (fee applies).

Wrapping Paper

Treat most wrapping paper as garbage. However, Kraft wrapping paper can be recycled in your curbside cart if folded flat.

Put IN Recycling Cart

Cardboard Boxes

Flatten before you put these in your recycling cart.

If the box is too big for your curbside recycling cart, cut it into smaller pieces so it fits. You can also bring corrugated cardboard boxes to the Olmsted County Recycling Center Plus.
